Come and Sing Messiah will take place on Saturday, April 4, at 7:00 pm, the day before Palm Sunday, at Church of the Redeemer, Pennswood and New Gulph Roads in Bryn Mawr. Singers should join us for a rehearsal at 2:30 pm that afternoon and can bring your brownbag for dinner between rehearsal and the performance. There is a suggested donation of \$10/singer and \$20/listener.

Following the tradition begun by Handel during his lifetime of performances of Messiah to benefit charities, proceeds will benefit the Interfaith Hospitality Network of the Main Line.
