Great Concerts for Great Causes Presents Brahms Requiem

The next performance on the Great Concerts for Great Causes series at Church of the Redeemer in Bryn Mawr, PA will be Sunday, November 9, at 4:00 pm. The Redeemer Choirs and Friends will perform the Brahms *Requiem*.

The performance will be conducted by Huw Williams, Music Director at Church of the Redeemer and will be accompanied by the piano duet of Joshua Stafford and James Batt. This unique accompaniment was arranged by Brahms himself and recently recorded to critical acclaim by the King's College Choir, England. Katy Gentry will perform the soprano solo and Stephanos Tsirakoglou is the baritone soloist.

Tickets for each concert are \$20 (\$15 for seniors and students—children under 12 free) and will be sold at the door on the day of the concert.

The concert series, part of the Church of the Redeemer's tradition of offering musical performances on Sundays at 4:00, supports the outreach program of the Church for the benefit of the African Children's Mission (HIV/AIDS services in Malawi, Africa) and Interfaith Hospitality Network of the Main Line (providing temporary shelter to homeless persons).
