Season Opens for Great Concerts for Great Causes

Oboeist Angela Williams will open the season for Redeemer Concerts supporting Great Concerts for Great Causes on Sunday, September 28 at 4:00 pm at Church of the Redeemer in Bryn Mawr. Ms. Williams will be accompanied on piano and organ by her husband, and Redeemer director of music, Huw Williams. The featured work on the program will be Francis Poulenc's delightful trio for oboe, bassoon and piano. Bassoonist Jonathan Malone will join Angela and Huw Williams for the performance of this work.

Angela Williams is a graduate of the Royal Conservatory of Music, London. The program will feature music by John Rutter, Telemann and Krebs. Ms. Williams will perform on the oboe, English horn and recorder.

Tickets for each concert are \$20 (\$15 for seniors and students—children under 12 free) and will be sold at the door on the day of the concert.

Great Concerts for Great Causes is an exceptional cultural program to support worthy charities. The concert series, part of the Church of the Redeemer's tradition of offering musical performances on Sundays at 4:00, supports the outreach program of the Church for the benefit of the African Children's Mission (HIV/AIDS services in Malawi, Africa) and Interfaith Hospitality Network of the Main Line (providing temporary shelter to homeless persons). The series offers young performers the opportunity to play and learn in a comfortable surrounding; many of whom have gone on to great musical acclaim.
